

# National Recognition with CLFMA Award



Hyderabad: **Professor Jyoti Palod** from the **College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pantnagar**, has been awarded the **CLFMA Award 2025** for her 30 years of dedicated service in teaching, research, and extension in livestock and poultry production. The award was presented during the 66th National Symposium of CLFMA of India at Hotel Taj Deccan, Hyderabad, on August 22, 2025. The honor was jointly conferred by Prof. S. P. Singh Baghel, Union Minister of

State for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, and Mr. Vakti Srihari, Minister of Animal Husbandry & Fisheries, Government of Telangana, in the presence of **Mr. Divya Kumar Gulati, President of CLFMA**, and other eminent dignitaries. Professor Palod's distinguished career spans over three decades, during which she has contributed extensively to animal nutrition, livestock production and poultry production. She has guided 11 postgraduate and 3 doctoral

students, authored impactful research papers, and worked at the grassroots level to improve farmers' livelihoods. She is among the few women scientists to receive the CLFMA Award, a recognition that underscores her role and inspirational journey in the livestock sector. Her achievement has been appreciated by members of various professional societies, students hailing her as a role model for the next generation.
